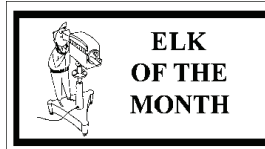

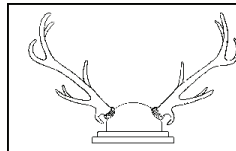

Cribbage League starts the First Wednesday in October and runs every Wednesday there after. Play starts at 7:00pm New players are more than welcome to join in.



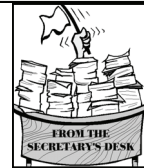
